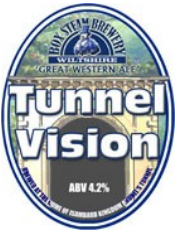

PintPicker: Overall Footprint



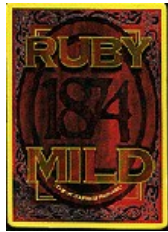
Box Steam Brewery

Deep red in colour, the flavour is well balanced creating a popular session beer.

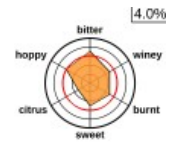


Castle Rock

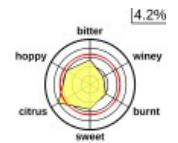
Great Oakley

JHB Jeffrey Hudson Bitter
3.8%
A golden beer whose aroma is dominated by hops that give characteristic citrus notes. Hops and fruit on the palate are balanced by malt and a bitter base. Dry hoppy finish with soft fruit flavours



Skidders

Cornish Blonde
5.0%
A combination of the highest quality wheat malt and British and American hops makes this light coloured wheat beer deceptively easy to drink with a superb citrus finish.



Titanic

Anchor
4.1%
This impressive russet gold beer has a strong fruity aroma. Bitterness in the initial taste slips gently from the mooring to allow the full impact of the hops to burst through.

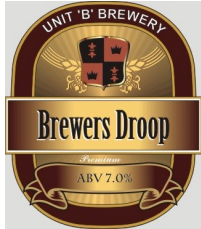
